BRAID INDICES OF SURFACE-KNOTS AND COLORINGS BY QUANDLES

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The braid index of a surface-knot F is the minimal number among the degrees of all simple surface braids whose closures are ambient isotopic to F. We give a lower bound of the braid index of a surface-knot by using the colorings by a quandle. As an application, we prove that an S^2 -knot which is the connected sum of s copies of the spun (n, 2)-torus knot has the braid index s + 2.

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
