

Brief travel instructions from Kansai Airport (added in Nov. 2011)

The trains operated by Japan Rail (JR) provide a fast, cheap, and convenient way to reach Osaka City University from Kansai (Osaka) Airport. The station for Osaka City University is called **Sugimoto-cho**. The **Kansai Kenshu Center (KKC)** and the Osaka City University guest house are ten minutes walk from Sugimoto-cho Station. After arriving at the airport, follow the signs for the JR station. You will need some Japanese cash to buy the train ticket (either from a ticket vending machine or the ticket office). Buy a ticket for **860 Japanese yen**. Then:

1. Get on a "Rapid" train (**Kankuu Kaisoku**) heading for Osaka and go to Sakai-shi Station (about 40 minutes). The train usually stops at these stations: **KANSAI AIRPORT, RINKUTOWN, HINENOKUMATORI, HIGASHIKISHIWADA, IZUMIFUCHU, OTORI, MIKUNIGAOKA(OSAKA), SAKAISHI** then goes on to **KYOBASHI**. (Do not get on any "Express" train such as "Haruka"!)

2. Transfer to a "local" train (going in the same direction) at Sakai-shi Station and get off at the second stop, Sugimoto-cho Station (4 minutes)

3. One can also get the KKC from the Sakai-shi Station by Taxi. The taxi cost is about **2000 Japanese yen** (not so cheap!), though it is easier.
